2012 Newport News, Va., Visitor Guide Now Available

Newport News, Va. – Money-saving coupons and useful information about the city’s attractions, events, dining, lodging and shopping are just some of the features of the new 28-page 2012 Newport News Visitor Guide.

This free, full-color publication – produced annually by the Newport News Tourism Development Office – is packed with information about all there is to see and do in the city, including information on events being held to commemorate the 150th Anniversary of the American Civil War in 2012.

Attractions profiled in the guide include The Mariners’ Museum/USS *Monitor* Center and the Virginia Living Museum, plus the City’s four historic homes – Endview Plantation, the James A. Fields House, Lee Hall Mansion and The Newsome House Museum & Cultural Center. Additional points of interest include the Peninsula Fine Arts Center, the US Army Transportation Museum and the Virginia War Museum. Each listing includes current admission prices and operating hours.

Seven coupons offered in the guide provide discounted admission to Endview Plantation, Lee Hall Mansion, The Mariners’ Museum, Peninsula Fine Arts Center, Peninsula SPCA Exotic Sanctuary and Petting Zoo, and the Virginia Living Museum. There’s also a coupon for 25% off any purchase over \$20 at the Newport News Visitor Center gift shop.

The guide also includes a page on the three performing arts venues in Newport News: Downing-Gross Cultural Arts Center, Ferguson Center for the Arts, and the Peninsula Community Theatre. A two-page dining guide lists 53 restaurants, both nationally-known chains and local favorites, and a four-page events calendar highlights some of the many festivals, special events, ongoing activities and exhibitions in Newport News and throughout Hampton Roads.
