Newport News Visitor Center Hires Two New Travel Counselors

Newport News, VA – Lorane Romanick and Vicky Newberry recently joined the Newport News Visitor Center as part-time travel counselors.

In their new roles, Lorane and Vicky will be responsible for providing tourism information to visitors, using maps to give directions, selling gift-shop merchandise, answering phone inquiries, proofing promotional materials, and assisting with bulk mail preparation and data entry.

Lorane, who has a B.S. in Environmental Science from Virginia Commonwealth University and an associate's degree in Clinical Pathology from Thomas Nelson Community College, has completed laboratory internships with Sentara/Walter Reed in Williamsburg and at Walter Reed Hospital in Gloucester. In addition to her job with the Visitor Center, Lorane works part-time as an eligibility counselor with Lackey Free Clinic in Yorktown.

Lorane has also worked as a sales associate with Yankee Candle in Williamsburg and as a guest services specialist with Colonial Williamsburg and the Jamestown-Yorktown Foundation.
