

Latest Newport News Promotional Video Shows All There Is To See and Do in the City

~Video also highlights attractions found in neighboring cities of Coastal Virginia~

Newport News, VA, Aug. 17, 2015 – The city's tourism office recently debuted its latest promotional video, called *Wake Up To Newport News*. Produced by Metro Productions, the video is action-packed and set to upbeat music while showing all there is to see and do in Newport News and the Coastal Virginia region.

In a mere 3 minutes and 5 seconds, the video follows a young couple through their visit to Newport News, from the time they wake up in their hotel room until the day ends with the sun dropping below the horizon of the mighty James River.

The video shows snippets of each of the city's museums, historic homes, and performing arts venues, along with those things Newport News is noted for – namely its world-renowned shipyard, historic sites and neighborhoods, public art, 30+ parks, wildlife, and its many miles of waterfront.

The video also manages to squeeze in all the outdoor fun found in Newport News – from paddle-boating, swimming, and fishing to golfing, bicycling and camping – plus it includes a montage of events, such as fireworks displays, antique car shows, annual festivals, afterwork parties with live music, the One City Marathon, along with other sports competitions held within the city.

As if that weren't enough, the video also features the city's close proximity to Williamsburg, Jamestown, Smithfield, Hampton, Norfolk, Portsmouth, and Virginia Beach – with all these cities have to offer visitors, too! The video ends with the couple standing hand-in-hand, watching the setting sun at Huntington Beach Park, and then embracing in a hug.
