

Latest Newport News Promotional Video Shows All There Is To See and Do in Huntington Park

~Video highlights Virginia War Museum, rose garden, public beach, tennis courts, children's playground, fishing, boating, and dining~

Newport News, VA, July 20, 2018 – The city's tourism office recently debuted its latest promotional video, called *Discover Huntington Park*. Produced by Seven Cities Media, the fast-paced video is set to lively music while showing all there is to see and do in this 60-acre park at the base of the James River Bridge.

From play dates to romantic dates, Huntington Park has something for everyone. In a mere 1 minute and 3 seconds, the video features people of all ages – from children and young adults to parents and grandparents – enjoying the park's sandy beach, playground, tennis courts, and rose garden, along with the Virginia War Museum, the James River Fishing Pier, and more!

Located at the intersection of Warwick and Mercury boulevards, Huntington Park also offers its visitors a public boat ramp, a large freshwater lake called Lake Biggins, a beach concession stand, two ballparks, and a quiet space with memorials in remembrance of the Vietnam War, the Holocaust, and the Four Chaplains of the USAT *Dorchester*.

The video ends with a gorgeous sunset dropping below the horizon of the mighty James River – taken from the nearby Crab Shack Restaurant, which specializes in fresh seafood and offers waterfront dining with a sweeping panoramic view of the James River.
