Abbreviated as AACE (and pronounced "Ace"), its mission is to create an inclusive and welcoming hub for travelers, positioning Newport News as a destination that embraces and celebrates diversity.

The campaign showcases African American art, culture, and history, along with the Black-owned businesses, of Newport News. The goal of the campaign is to attract new visitors to the city, engage regional residents, and support local businesses by showcasing spaces that highlight the Black experience in Newport News. African American majority-owned or operated businesses are invited to be a part of this movement by becoming an AACE Enterprise Partner and making your place an AACE Space. To officially launch AACE and in celebration of Black Music Month, Newport News Tourism will hold an event called **Music Through the Decades**. The event, to be held from 5 to 8:30 p.m. June 5 in City Center at Oyster Point, will feature the iconic sounds of Black music from various decades, changing every hour.
